## CANADIAN ATTORNEY IN FACT PROCESS BINDING AUTHORITY ENDORSEMENT

(For Non-Canadian Domiciled Coverholders)

The following paragraph is added to Sub-section 6.1 of the Schedule - OTHER CONDITIONS, REQUIREMENTS AND/OR AMENDMENTS RELATING TO THE OPERATION OF THE AGREEMENT:

In the event that the Coverholder is domiciled outside of Canada and is authorised by the Underwriters as per Sub-sections 9.1 and/or 9.2 to enter into contracts of insurance where the insured, risk or part of the exposure on a global risk is Canadian ('Canadian risk(s)'):

- a) the Coverholder shall ensure that all certificates, or any other Insurer authorised documents evidencing insurances bound, issued by the Coverholder on behalf of the Underwriters in respect of such Canadian risk(s) are sent to the Lloyd's Canadian Attorney-In-Fact to confirm coverage as a Canadian contract and to communicate the issuance of that Canadian contract to the policyholder/his broker; and
- b) the final paragraph of Sub-section 24.2 of the Agreement is deleted and replaced with the following:

The accounting information whether presented by bordereaux or in an alternative manner shall be reported at the interval stated in 24.2 of the Schedule until every insurance bound has expired or has otherwise been cancelled or terminated and, additionally, the accounting information in respect of insurances bound under the Agreement where the insured, risk or part of the exposure on a global risk is Canadian shall include a statement that the certificates, or any other Insurer authorised documents evidencing insurances bound for such Canadian risk(s) have been bound by the Lloyd's Canadian Attorney-In-Fact in Canada.
