**Revised October 2003 Test Date**

The date of the next Lloyd's Introductory Test has changed from 9<sup>th</sup> October to **1<sup>st</sup> October 2003**. The venue for the test has also moved from the University of London Examination Halls **to the Bishopsgate Institute**.

Candidates will receive instructions on how to find the Bishopsgate Institute approximately one month in advance of the test date.

All candidates who have registered already or register from now on for the October 2003 test will be notified of the changes.

**Increased Frequency of Tests in 2004**

With effect from 01 January 2004 the frequency of the LIT tests will be increased from three to four times a year. The dates for 2004 are as follows:

4<sup>th</sup> February 2004  
15<sup>th</sup> June 2004  
8<sup>th</sup> September 2004  
24<sup>th</sup> November 2004

All the tests in 2004 will be held at the Bishopsgate Institute.
