We have revised our Scale of Charges for all new business presented to the Certificates Office from 1 January 2006. Our new charges which apply to ALL Lloyd's marine insurance certificates on laser security paper, are as set out below:

<b>Certificate Production Costs</b> <i>(Riders will be charged at 50% of the rates detailed below).</i>	
<b>Quantity</b>	<b>Cost per certificate</b>
Orders of 0-499	£2.20
Orders of 500-999	£1.65
Orders of 1000-1499	£1.15
Orders of 1500-2999	£0.80
Orders of 3000-4999	£0.55
Orders of 5000+	£ negotiable

These figures constitute an increase of approximately 10% over a 3 year period (see our Market Bulletin 10<sup>th</sup> January 2003).

The above-mentioned charges are based on the assumption that the certificates are printed on laser security paper in four part sets (original, duplicate and two copies). Any other requirements are subject to our approval, and may be charged at an enhanced price (see our Market Bulletin dated 1<sup>st</sup> August 2004). All prices stated above are exclusive of V.A.T.

The costs for production of Lloyd's Electronic Cargo Certificates will remain unchanged.
