Eamonn Egan, Lloyd's Country Manager for Ireland, will be appointed as Managing Director, Lloyd's Ireland Representative Limited and will assume responsibility for all regulatory and compliance functions. Eamonn will also be responsible for strengthening Lloyd's existing relationships – and developing new ones - with insurance buyers in the Irish market.
