



The Adam Room is an incredibly special space and has hosted important guests at Lloyd's, including HM Queen Elizabeth II. An adaptation of the original dining room of Bowood House in Wiltshire, designed in 1763 for the first Earl of Shelbourne, it is considered to be an important early work of Robert Adam, the famous Scottish architect who had just returned from Rome full of enthusiasm for re-establishing the architecture of classical antiquity.
