

Lloyd's Middle East & Turkey – FAQ

Q: How many offices does Lloyd's have in the Middle East & Turkey?

A: One. Located in the Dubai International Finance Centre in Dubai, United Arab Emirates

Q: Is Lloyd's licensed to write business directly in any of the countries in the region?

A: No. All of the business we write is reinsurance of insurers licensed to do business in these countries.

Q: My enquiry relates to the Lloyds Bank – am I in the right place?

A: No – We are Lloyd's of London, the global insurance and reinsurance marketplace. We have no relation to Lloyds Bank despite the similarity of names.

Q: I wish to report a claim. How do I do this?

A: Contact your insurance broker, or the Lloyd's office who issued the policy. Make sure you have the policy number to hand.

Q: What Lines of Business does Lloyd's MET cover?
