What you need to know

The Fair Practices Regulation has been amended to remove the exceptions to electronic insurance transactions, which allows insurers to conduct insurance transactions electronically, providing the consumer gives prior consent.

The Insurance Agents and Adjusters Regulation has been amended to allow the General Insurance Council to consider equivalences to qualification examinations for general insurance agents. The agent must have passed a course or an examination that the Alberta Insurance Council has accepted as equivalent and should not be older than 12 months of the application.
