- 1. The candidate (corporate member) named in SECTION A (1) is a C-external member of the Society and hereby applies to stand for election as a C-external member of the Council of Lloyd's. The candidate has secured the full support and consent of other C-external member(s) of the Society holding solely or in aggregate two per cent (2%) or more of the voting capacity attributable to all C-external members of the Society who will remain as C-external member(s) at least until 5 October 2020 (the nominations date) as its nominators (as indicated in SECTION C of this form).
- 2. As evidenced in the copy of the certified copy of the board minutes attached to this nomination form, the Board of the candidate (corporate member) named in SECTION A (1) has nominated the undersigned, as the individual who will, if elected, act as its representative at Council meetings and in relation to the business of the Council as a whole.
- 3. I being the individual nominated to be the corporate member's representative confirm that the information provided in this form (on behalf of both the member and myself as its nominated representative) is accurate and complete to the best of my knowledge and belief and that I have read the guidance notes in SECTION E of this form. As the candidate's nominated representative, I will notify the General Counsel & Company Secretary immediately if there is a material change to the information provided.
- 4. I understand and agree that the details provided in Sections A(1), A(2) and C of this form may be provided to all members of the Society of Lloyd's ("Lloyd's") in the candidate booklet which is sent to members of Lloyd's and which accompanies the ballot paper.
- I authorise the Society of Lloyd's to make such enquiries and seek such further information as it thinks appropriate to identify and verify information that it considers relevant to the assessment of this nomination. I acknowledge and agree that these checks may include credit reference checks or information pertaining to fitness and propriety.
- 6. I confirm that, if applicable, I have disclosed, on behalf of the candidate and myself as the candidate's nominated representative all Lloyd's-related and other interests and those of connected persons which might conflict with our duties as an elected Council member or as a nominated representative.
- 7. I confirm that, if applicable, I have disclosed, on behalf of the candidate and myself as the candidate's nominated representative the details of any previous service on the Board or Council for any periods during which I was a member of the Council, a nominated representative of a corporate member or a member of the Franchise Board.
- 8. I confirm that, if elected, I undertake to notify the General Counsel & Company Secretary of all my and the corporate member's Lloyd's-related and other interests and those of persons connected with the corporate member or me and full details of the corporate member's and my underwriting (if any) on the basis prescribed from time to time by the General Counsel & Company Secretary. This information will be recorded on a register which will be available for inspection by, and where appropriate copied to, any member of the Society. The information will reflect my and the corporate member's current relevant interests and I will make regular notifications of relevant interests and of material changes in any of the information I have provided.

- 9. I confirm and agree that, if elected, I will also execute a Deed of Undertaking on behalf of the corporate member and myself in the required form.
- 10. I also agree to comply with any additional requirements as to the disclosure of interests that may be required by the PRA and/or the FCA including under the Financial Services and Markets Act 2000 as amended ("FSMA") or any legislation subordinate thereto.
- 11. I understand and agree that, if elected as a member of Council / the nominated representative of the member, I will be required to devote a substantial amount of time to the affairs of Lloyd's and am prepared to do so.
- 12. I understand and agree that, if elected, I will be required to complete conduct rule training in accordance with the Senior Managers and Certification Regime.
- 13. I confirm that I understand that there are mechanisms in place to resolve potential conflicts of interest between connected Council members.
- 14. I confirm that I understand that, if elected, the terms of my appointment will be subject to additional requirements relating to my fitness and propriety including the PRA/FCA requirement for Lloyd's to seek regulatory references for the previous five years of service from my current and previous employer(s) and organisations at which I am, or have been, a non-executive director during that period. I confirm that I understand that such requirements may not necessarily be within the control of the Council and the Society. I further confirm that I will at all times endeavour to comply with such additional requirements as may from time to time be notified to me.
- 15. I confirm that, in the event that I am elected, if at any time I fail to meet any requirements concerning fitness and propriety or any other criteria applicable to members of the Council of Lloyd's arising from Lloyd's or from the PRA and/or the FCA (including arising out of FSMA or any legislation subordinate thereto) or the regulatory references referred in paragraph 14 above that are received by Lloyd's are not considered by Lloyd's to be acceptable, I shall resign from office as the representative of the corporate member immediately on being notified that, by reason of such failure, I am required to vacate office.
- 16. In the event that I am elected and I subsequently have to resign as its representative, whether in relation to any requirement or provision, including any requirement or provision made by Lloyd's or made by the PRA and/or the FCA or in connection with FSMA, or otherwise, I acknowledge and agree that such loss of office shall not give rise to any claim against the Society for compensation or damages or for any other remedy.

SECTION E

GUIDANCE NOTES FOR CANDIDATES

General Guidance

- 1. It is the responsibility of candidates and its nominated representative to ensure that this form is fully completed and submitted on time.
- 2. These elections are governed by the Constitutional Arrangements Byelaw (No. 2 of 2010) (the Byelaw).

Eligibility

- 3. Only those who are registered as C-external members of the Society on 21 September 2020 (the notice of election date) are entitled to stand in the election. Candidates who have ceased to be a C-external member by the ballot date on 20 November 2020 shall not be eligible to become a member of Council.
- 4. In order to stand in the election, candidates must have been nominated for election by one or more other C-external member(s) of the Society who alone, or in aggregate, hold at least two per cent (2%) or more of the voting capacity (including open years) attributable to all C-external members. In addition, nominators must be registered as C-external members of the Society on 5 October 2020 (the nominations date).
- 5. Under the Definitions Byelaw (No.7 of 2005) for the purposes of Council elections, a corporate member which is not beneficially owned in whole or in part by; (i) a financial services group¹, (ii) a publicly traded company, or (iii) an investment fund², which has elected in good faith to be an individual external member of the Society and that election has been accepted by the Council is an individual external member of the Society, not a C-external member. Only C-external members can nominate a candidate in the C-external constituency.
- 6. If the Candidate or the Candidate's nominated representative has already served more than 9 years (in aggregate) in their own right or as a representative of a corporate member on the Council or Franchise Board in any capacity (other than as an Executive Director) they are not eligible for nomination for a term commencing sooner than 3 years after the expiry of their previous last term.
- 7. In accordance with paragraph 5.17 of the Constitutional Arrangements Byelaw (No 2 of 2010) each candidate shall submit a statement of previous service, identifying any periods during which the candidate or its nominated representative was a member of the Council, a nominated representative of a corporate member of Council or a member of the Franchise Board.
- 8. In addition, C-external members who are connected with an incumbent working or external member of Council or who meet any of the other circumstances set out in paragraph 5.28 of the Byelaw <u>are not eligible for nomination</u>. The Byelaw provides that a working or external member of Council is connected with another working or external member of Council where:
 - (a) They are companies in the same corporate group which corporate group includes a corporate member, an underwriting agent, or a Lloyd's broker;

- (b) They are directors or employees in the same corporate group which corporate group includes a corporate member, an underwriting agent, or a Lloyd's broker; or
- (c) One member of the Council is a director, partner, employee, agent or controller of or in the other member of the Council.

Where these circumstances apply or would apply if you are elected, you are not eligible for nomination to Council. In the event that a working or external member of Council becomes connected with another working or external member of Council after they have been elected the Byelaw provides for the member with the longer term of office remaining to cease to be a member of Council. The vacancy arising as a result will be filled in accordance with arrangements determined by the Council in accordance with its powers under the Byelaw.

Number of seats available

9. There are two C-external member seats in this election. If only two candidates are validly nominated, those candidates will be declared to be elected and a ballot will not be held.

Completing SECTION A of the Form

SECTION A (1) Questions 7, 8, 9, 26, 27 and 28: Disclosure of relevant interests

- 10. Candidates and their nominated representatives are required to disclose their own interests and those of connected persons in Lloyd's-related and other insurance entities. Candidates and their nominated representatives should also disclose any other interests, including any potential conflicts of interest which may be considered to conflict with their duties as an elected member of Council. It is for candidates and nominated representatives to determine whether a particular Lloyd's related or other interest may conflict or may reasonably be perceived to conflict with their duties as an elected member of Council and should therefore be disclosed in SECTION A of the Candidature Form.
- 11. For the avoidance of doubt, however, candidates and nominated representatives should disclose the following:
 - (a) Other appointments currently held by the candidate, its nominated representatives, and their connected persons (executive & non-executive);
 - (b) beneficial interests of the candidate, its nominated representatives, and their connected persons in Lloyd's-related and other insurance entities whether listed or not (other than shareholdings of three per cent (3%) or less in a non-Lloyd's-related company);
 - (c) directorships, partnerships, employment or other appointments of candidates, their nominated representatives or connected persons in Lloyd's-related or other insurance entities:
 - (d) remuneration, fees etc. of candidates or their nominated representative (but not of connected persons) received from Lloyd's-related or other insurance entities; and
 - (e) other relevant Lloyd's-related or insurance interests of the candidate, their nominated representative or his/her connected persons which should be disclosed.
- 12. For the purpose of this form "connected person" means:
 - (a) a nominated representative's spouse, civil partner, parent, brother, sister, child or step-child under the age of 18 or a candidate's spouse's or civil partner's parent, brother, sister, child or step-child under the age of 18 (together the nominated representative's family);

- (b) a trustee (acting as such) of any trust of which the candidate or nominated representative or any of the nominated representative's family is a beneficiary or discretionary object (other than a trust which is either an occupational pension scheme or an employee's share scheme which does not, in either case, have the effect of conferring benefits on persons all or most of whom are related parties);
- (c) a body corporate <u>controlled</u> by the candidate or nominated representative alone or by the candidate (or nominated representative) and persons connected together, or with which a candidate (or nominated representative) or persons connected with him/her is associated³;
- (d) a limited liability partnership in which:
 - (i) a candidate (or nominated representative) is a member; or
 - (ii) a member is a person who, by virtue of sub-paragraphs 11(a), 11(b) or 11(c) above is connected with the candidate (or nominated representative); or
 - (iii) a member is a limited liability partnership or a Scottish limited partnership in which the candidate (or nominated representative) is a member or partner respectively or in which there is a member or partner who, by virtue of subparagraphs 11(a), 11(b) or 11(c) above is connected with the candidate (or nominated representative);
- (e) a Scottish limited partnership in which:
 - (i) a candidate (or nominated representative) is a partner; or
 - (ii) a partner is a person who, by virtue of sub-paragraphs 11(a), 11(b) or 11(c) above is connected with the candidate (or nominated representative); or
 - (iii) a partner is a limited liability partnership or a Scottish limited partnership in which the candidate (or nominated representative) is a member or partner or in which there is a member or partner who, by virtue of sub-paragraphs 11(a), 11(b) or 11(c) above is connected with the candidate (or nominated representative).

SECTION A (2) Question 1: Candidate's electoral statement

- 13. This should be the candidate's manifesto to the electorate and should explain why the candidate should be elected to Council. Where possible, candidates should avoid reciting biographical details already covered in the candidature form.
- 14. The Council of Lloyd's reserves the right to reduce and/or delete content where the 400 word limit is exceeded and/or if it is reasonably satisfied that the statement contains defamatory material, misleading information or any other information which it deems not to be in the interests of the Society.

Completing SECTION B of the Form

15. Members of Council and their nominated representatives need to be notified to the PRA and the FCA and are designated as key function holders under the Senior Managers and Certification Regime. As a consequence, Lloyd's is required to ensure that members of
