

Applications for the Lloyd's Market Charity Awards are now open!

The Lloyd's Market Charity Awards recognise individuals across the Lloyd's corporation and Lloyd's market who have made a significant contribution of time to charity through volunteering and fundraising. The Lloyd's of London Foundation (previously Lloyd's Charities Trust) recognises these amazing individuals in the Lloyd's market through an unrestricted donation to their nominated charity.

In 2022, Lloyd's of London Foundation will be donating to six winning charities who will receive a grant between £15,000 - £25,000.

Applications close on **2 October 2022 23:59** and winners will be notified after that date.

Eligibility:

- **Permanent employees working in the Lloyd's market and employed by:**
 - Lloyd's corporation
 - Managing or members' agent
 - Lloyd's registered broker
 - Coverholder
- Applicants must be employed by one of the above on the date that the application and award is made
- Applicants need to demonstrate direct and sustained personal engagement with their nominated charity during the past 12 months, for example as a volunteer, fundraiser, trustee, or beneficiary of services provided
- Individuals who won a Lloyd's Market Charity Award in 2021 will not be eligible
- You can nominate someone else to receive an award to recognise their volunteering or fundraising efforts in the last 12 months

Charity specification:

Lloyd's of London Foundation trustees will be looking for applications on behalf of:

- Charities or Community Interest Companies (CICs) that benefit from the active involvement of a person or people working within the Lloyd's market
- Charities that have supported the applicant during difficult times
- Smaller, local charities who might struggle to receive funding

The following will not be eligible for an award:

- Organisations that are not registered charities
- Political parties or lobbying organisations
- Grant-making bodies to make grants on our behalf
- The promotion of religion or other beliefs
- Individuals, including student grants, bursaries, medical costs, or financial assistance
- Applications towards the personal expenses of individuals participating in fundraising events such as overseas treks, entry fees, sponsorship or any other costs associated with fundraising activities
- Organisations whose objectives might be deemed to be detrimental to the objectives of the Lloyd's market

Application form guidance:

- Please provide your name, surname, email address, phone number, job title, and company name
- Include details of your involvement with the charity within the last 12 months (e.g., volunteering frequency, role, amount raised or other personal involvement)
- Why you would like the charity to receive the donation
- Where your involvement with the charity has been as part of a team or group, please make clear your specific contributions to the activities
- Guidance on how the donation might be used by the charity (if available)

Please note that information entered will be **automatically saved** should you wish to complete and submit your application form at a later stage. However, if you are on a public or shared computer, we recommend that you complete and submit your form in a single session to maintain the security of any sensitive information. You will not be able to download or print a copy of the completed form, so you may wish to save key data into a separate document for your records.

Application assessment:

- Applications are reviewed by Lloyd's of London Foundation Trustees
- Decisions regarding eligibility of applicants or beneficiaries, or interpretation of any of the other rules of the awards will be at the discretion of the trustees
- Trustees will seek to make awards to reflect the diversity of the applications and the market itself.
- The trustees' decision is final
- Winners will be announced in Autumn 2022

Data protection

The personal data you have voluntarily provided will be collected, processed, retained and used by Lloyd's for the purpose of making a decision about the suitability of this application to the Lloyd's Market Charity Awards Scheme. Lloyd's will collect, process, store and use your personal data in accordance with the Data Protection Act 2018 and keep your details confidential unless required to disclose by law or any competent governmental or regulatory or tax authority.

Your personal data will be stored for three years as required by our auditors, or for such period as may be required by law from time to time.
