### What you need to know

At a time when automobile theft has increased significantly across the country, the *Groupement des assureurs automobiles* (GAA) created a new database of Vehicle Identification Numbers (called infoNIV) to speed up the identification of the owner of a stolen vehicle.

By associating the VIN of a recovered vehicle with the insurer's name on file, the authorities will be able to notify the insurer of the vehicle's status more quickly.

#### What's changed

In light of the above, please note the following change in Lineage:

The VIN will now be mandatory for Québec Automobile policies with the exception of fleets not individually rated, motorcycles, snowmobiles, all-terrain vehicles and garage policies individually rated.

#### What this means to you

The VIN is to be reported for all transactions where the policy effective date is **on or after February 1, 2025**.

Note that when a valid VIN is entered, Lineage will automatically populate the Vehicle Code and Vehicle Year.
